

(AEAZM) Azumah confirms mineralisation at Basabli, Kuo

Sydney - Monday - September 1: (RWE Aust Business News) - **Azumah Resources** (ASX:AZM) has confirmed the mineralisation at the Basabli and Kuo targets, reinforcing the prospectivity of the Wa-Lawra gold project, Ghana.

Highlights of the latest drilling include 11m at 2.81 grams per tonne gold from 69m (Basabli), 3m at 1.24g/t from 31m (Kuo), 29m at 4.6g/t from 100m (Bepkong) and 43m at 2.05g/t from 70m (Bepkong).

Azumah has delineated a 516,000 resource at the Kunche deposit and will shortly release a resource for the Bepkong deposit, both in the Wa-Lawra project.

At Kuo, the discovery of mineralisation has resulted in a substantial upgrade of this target's ranking and a comprehensive soil sampling and drilling program will be undertaken.

At Basabli the drilling investigated possible extensions to the anomalous mineralisation intersected during the last reconnaissance drilling and demonstrates that the prospectivity and gold endowment of the Wa-Lawra is not just confined to Kunche-Bepkong but elsewhere in the entire 100km of prospective terrain.
